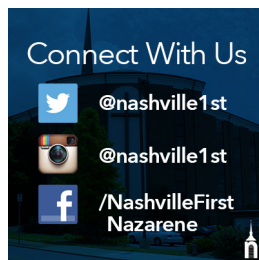


### MIDSOUTH DISTRICT ASSEMBLY
