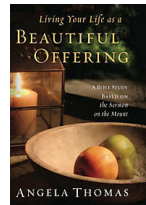

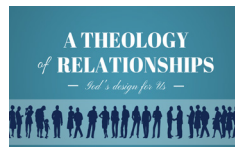
## TREVECCA "AWAKEN"
