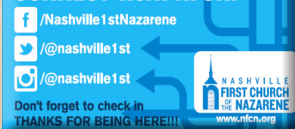

**PASSION FOR GREATER NASHVILLE**

*Rome was the largest and most magnificent city of its day, with a population of more than 1,000,000 people...When the apostle Paul entered Rome as a prisoner about A.D. 58, the city boasted of a history extending back more than 800 years...The city featured more than 400 temples dedicated to worship of pagan gods. It was also noted for its public buildings, baths, aqueducts, arches, temples, and roads.*

*The citizens of Rome received food and entertainment from the government. Wine was cheap and plentiful. Admission to the Roman games was free...the city of Rome became a symbol of idolatry and paganism...The New Open Bible, Study Edition*

### ROMANS 1:1-17 (NLT)

**1:7** – The people of Rome were loved and called by God to be His own holy people.  
**So are we in Greater Nashville!**

**1:8** – The reputation of the Roman Christians was positive and known around the world, even in this pagan idolatrous city!

**What is ours?**

**1:10-12** – The strategy of Paul was to visit and personally encourage the Roman Christians. Encouragement became key to the strategy!

Greek **sumparaklēthēnai** – to exhort together, to be strengthened with.

**Are we encouraging each other on a consistent basis?**

**1:13-15** – The passion of Paul is evident in these verses, and he is eager to come to them and preach the good news of the Gospel. Eager = ready, willing.  
**Is our NFCN ministry driven by eager passion?**

**1:16-17** – The methodology of Paul was evident – everything begins and ends with the message of the Gospel.
